Are you doing anything fun this summer? Maybe you are going on vacation with your parents or spending some time at the beach? Maybe you will be doing some other fun things like:

A good way to have some money to spend at these places is to save ahead of time. You can deposit (put) your money into your share (savings) account at the credit union. You can put allowance, chore money or report card money into your account and let it grow.

You and your parents can sit down and decide how much money you need (this is your goal). Together you can decide how much to save and how much to spend. This is called making a budget.

Remember:

-  You can get 1 wiggly dollar for every \$5 you deposit.
-  The money in your share account earns extra money called a dividend.

It's fun to save money and watch it grow!
